



HEARTLAND FISH CAMP!



We would like to give our riders an experience they won't easily forget at Heartland Fish Camp (normally known as HHEAL) the week of May 21-26th, 2018. This is the last week of school for Highlands County as well as our last week before our 2-week break from sessions at the barn, so we would like to give our riders and clients a little party! (And a reminder about the 2 weeks' break!)

The arena will become our "fishin' hole" for the riders and our picnic area will be transformed into our craft and game area for either those who are not riding or those who are waiting their turn to have their lesson. Clients can choose from a fish painting craft or a "fishin' hole" toss game (corn hole). They can go home with a goodie bag of fish tattoos, stickers, and flippin' frogs if they are able to catch a fish at the kiddie pool in the arena, or just for being there if they aren't riding. While these activities are going on our students will be munching on goldfish (crackers), gummy worms, and Swedish fish, and washing it down with worm juice (green Kool-Aid).

The sensory arena will be set up with an obstacle course which will include the fishin' hole located at the stationary table on the R side of the arena where the kiddie pool is located. We will place magnetic fish in the pool and the riders will be required to pick up the magnetic fishing pole from the barrel and try to "catch" a fish while mounted, and transfer the fish to a bucket. Completing this task will win them their goodie bag as mentioned above.

Hope to have good weather for these days of sessions; if not, this can easily be set up under cover.
