The correct answer is A, the withers.

A horse's measurement in hands is equal to the measurement from the ground to their withers.



True or false: all horses need shoes?

- A) true
- B) false

The correct answer is B, false. A horse's body type and exercise regimen will determine whether or not they need shoes.



What is 1 benefit of using a rope halter over a leather halter?

- A) rope halters are prettier than leather halters
- B) rope halters have knots on pressure points
- C) rope halters can break if the horse gets stuck
- D) rope halters are easier to put on the horse

The correct answer is B, rope halters have knots on the horse's pressure points that can make them easier to manage and train.



True or false: you should always turn a horse out with a breakaway halter?

- A) true
- B) false

The correct answer is A, true. If the horse gets caught on something unsupervised, a breakaway halter will help protect them.
