The correct answer is B, false. Horses hooves don't have feeling, so putting shoes on a horse is a painless procedure.



What do horses wear on their hooves?

- A) ice skates
- B) ballet slippers
- C) tap dancing shoes
- D) iron horse shoes

The correct answer is D, iron horse shoes.

Although not all horses wear horse shoes, many riding horses wear them to protect their feet.



Where is the one place a horse can't see?

- A) Right in front of them
- B) Right behind them
- C) to the left
- D) to the right
- E) A and B

The correct answer is E: A and B. Horses have a "blind spot" directly in front of and behind them.
