
What is it called when a horse runs really fast?

The correct answer is B, false.

A pony is a term for a horse under 14.2 hands, NOT a baby horse.



Which of the following terms refer to the equipment used to ride a horse?

- A) saddle
- B) reins
- C) bit
- D) all of the above

The correct answer is D, all of the above.

The saddle, reins, and bit are all used to ride a horse.



True or false: the reins are used to help steer the horse?

- A) true
- B) false

The correct answer is A, true.

Riders use their reins to tell the horse what direction they want to go.
