The correct answer is B, a female horse who is less than 4 years old. Fillies are older than yearlings but not yet an adult.

The correct answer is A, true.  
A colt is older than a yearling but not yet a stallion.



What is a gelding?

- B) a baby horse
- C) a pregnant horse
- D) a male horse who can't make foals anymore

The correct answer is D, a male horse who can't make foals anymore. A stallion is a male horse who can make foals.



Which of the following is not a part of the horse?

- A) hoof
- B) withers
- C) poll
- D) all of the above are parts of the horse

The correct answer is D, all of the above are parts of the horse.
